A graduate of the Jamaica School of Agriculture in 1964 and Cornell University where he qualified as a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine in 1970, Dr Clifford Bradford has worked in the racing industry for over four decades.

Involvement in the breeding industry and ownership of horses for racing by Dr. Bradford has yielded spectacular results. Maintaining a diverse level of participation, he has been part of no fewer than nine syndicates.



Along with trainer Philip Feanny and breeder Ivan 'Bobby' Clarke this syndicate won the owner's championship in 1993. The Bradford, Feanny and Clarke partnership owned Vestia the 1993 Superstakes winner, as well as Eros 1994 Horse-of-the-Year, a Hall of Fame inductee and one of the fastest ever to race and still the holder of three track records: over 1200 metres, 1300 metres and 1400 metres.
